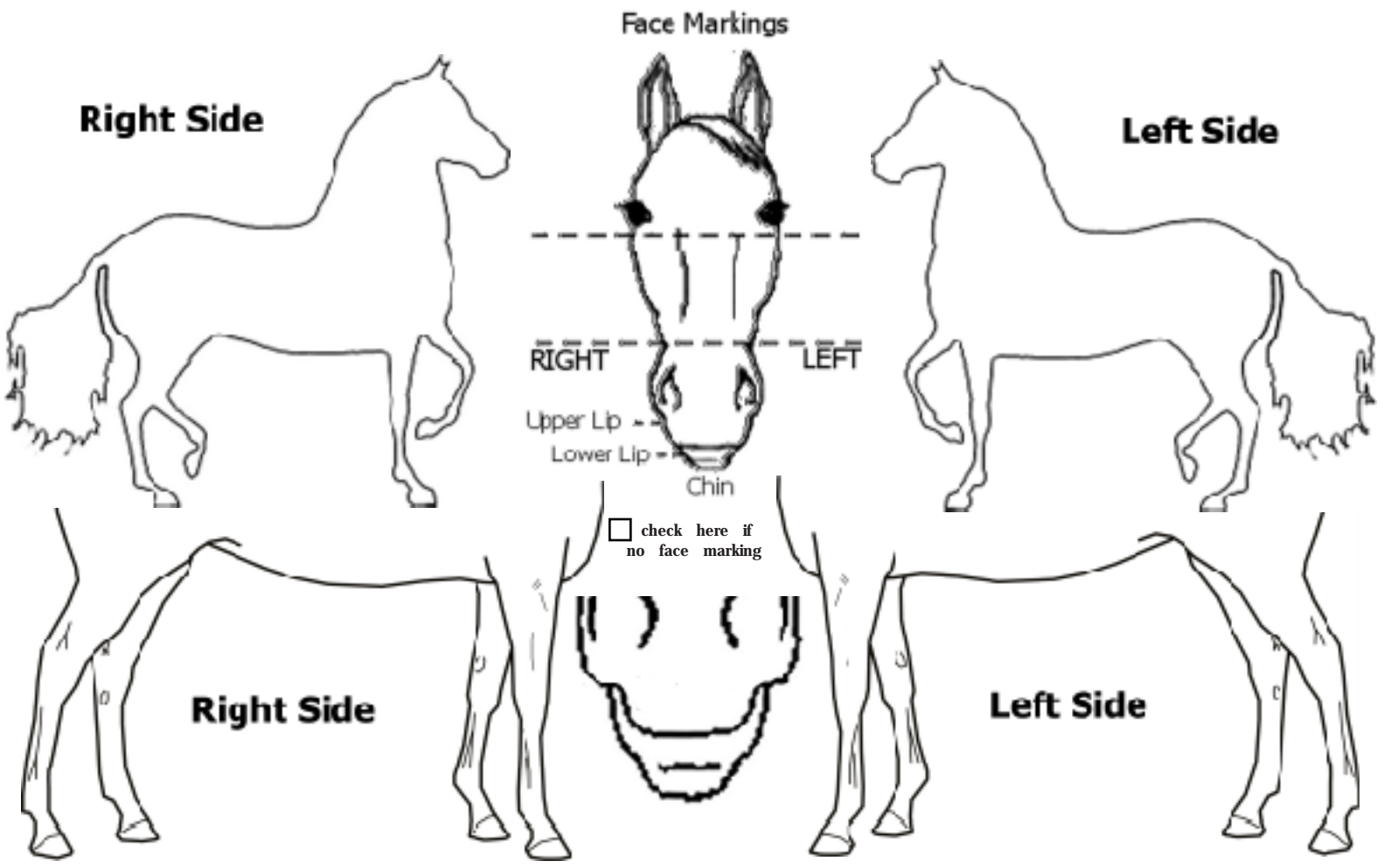

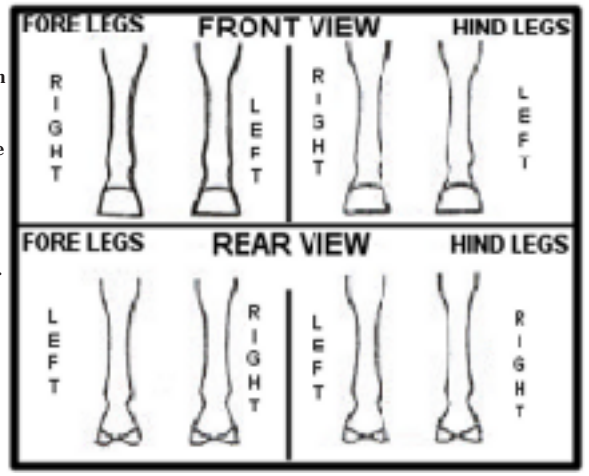

1. Drawings: Draw first in pencil, then shade dark areas with red ink.

2. COAT COLOR (check one)

- Chestnut:** shades from goldenred to dark reddish brown. Mane, tail and legs are not black but are the color of the body or shades darker or lighter.
- Black/Dark Chestnut:** basically black with the exception of red hairs on the coronet, pasterns or back of fetlocks.
- Bay:** reddish shades from reddish tan to dark mahogany brown. All bay horses have black manes and tails and black legs below the knees and hocks.
- Black:** true black without any light areas.
- Brown:** black with light mealy areas at muzzle, eyes and inside of legs.
- Palomino:** very pale creamy yellow to golden yellow, flaxen, silver or white mane and tail.
- Creme:** an ivory colored coat with mane and tail the same color or slightly darker. Eyes are light, usually blue.
- Dun:** yellowish with darker dorsal stripe and sometimes stripes on legs. Mane and tail not black.
- Buckskin:** darker shade of dun with black dorsal stripe, black mane and tail and black on lower legs.
- Roan:** A horse color resulting from a mixture of white other color hairs, does not lighten with age.

For horses already registered in another registry, a copy of the Horse's Other Registry registration papers and blood-typing card or DNA information must accompany this Application. All horses submitted for registration with Spanish Jennet Horse Society Atigrado division for foundation registration must be videotaped after the age of 6 months, clearly displaying the entire horse, showing all markings, and clearly showing the horse executing a natural even four-beat gait. Any horse, which cannot clearly show a four-beat gait, is not eligible for registration.
